1. Introduction

The Project of the Year – Public Sector Award recognizes exceptional Facility Management projects within the public sector that have demonstrated excellence in sustainability, digitalization, and technology-driven Facility Management practices.

2. Eligibility

- Public sector Facility Management projects
 - Government entities and authorities
 - Public facilities and infrastructure projects
 - Projects may be completed or ongoing
 - One submission per project per category
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3. Submission Requirements

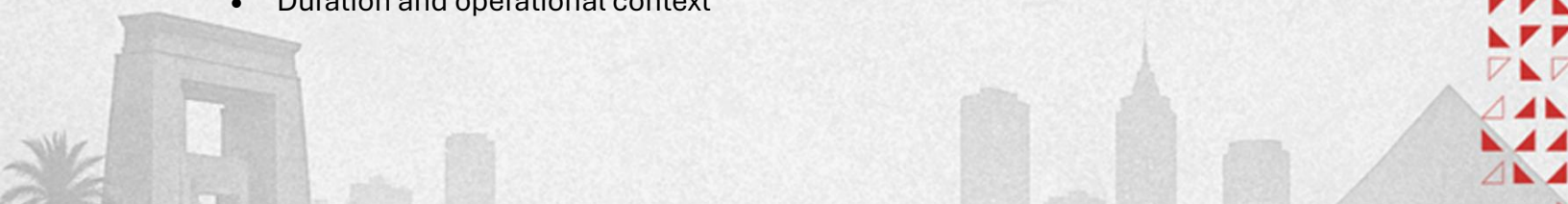
- One consolidated PDF file
 - Recommended length: 10–15 pages
 - Language: English
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4. Suggested Submission Structure

Section 1: Project Overview

Provide an overview of the project, including:

- Project name and owner
- Facility type and scope
- Duration and operational context



Section 2: Sustainability & Digitalization Objectives

Explain how sustainability and digitalization objectives were defined, including:

- Environmental and operational targets
- Digital transformation goals
- Alignment with public sector strategies or policies

Section 3: Planning and Execution

Describe how the project planned and executed sustainability and digitalization initiatives, including:

- Project governance and planning approach
- Implementation phases
- Stakeholder coordination

Section 4: Technology Integration

Explain how technology was integrated to support Facility Management operations, such as:

- Digital FM platforms or systems
- Smart building technologies
- Automation, monitoring, or data analytics tools

Section 5: Measurable Impact and Results

Demonstrate the impact of implementation using measurable outcomes, such as:

- Energy or water savings
- Operational efficiency improvements
- Cost optimization
- Service quality and user satisfaction improvements



Section 6: Supporting Evidence

Include charts, dashboards, reports, certifications, audits, or official documentation where applicable.

5. Evaluation Criteria

Submissions will be evaluated based on:

- Relevance to public sector Facility Management
 - Clarity of objectives and execution approach
 - Effective use of technology
 - Measurable performance outcomes
